Togaintheirattentionandwakethemup, teacherplays YES/NOgame in whichtheteachershowsstudentspicturesaboutthelastweek'sunitandtells them a statement, studentsmoveto YES or NO accordingtothestatement. (5 min.)

Teacherpoints at thepicturesandsaystheemotions; sleepy, anxious, moody. Teacherthenteaches how toaskaboutemotions; how is she/he? Teacherthenpoints at thepicturesandsaystheweather; rainy, cloudy, windy, sunny, snowy. Teacherteaches how to ask theweather; what'stheweatherlike? Thenplays a song. Theysingtogether. (9 min.)</p>

Studentssticktheclothingstotheaccordingweatherperson. Fastestgrouptofinishalltheweatherswin. (10min)</p> <p>Second activity is a guessinggame. Onestudentcomestothe board. Teacherwrites a wordbehindthestudent. Thestudentdoesn'tknowwhat is writtenandtheirclassmatestrytoexplainthewordtothestudent on the board. Nextstudentcomesto board whenthestudent on the board guessessthewordcorrectly.(8min)</p> <p>Lastactivity is drawing. Teacherhandsoutpaperswithblankfaces on themthat has an emotionwrittenatop. Thestudentsdrawandcolourthepaperhowevertheylike, representingtheemotionwritten on thepaper.” (10min)</p>
